**RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENT OF THE NEW RICHMOND
EXEMPTED VILLAGE SCHOOL DISTRICT TO TRANSFER FUNDS
FROM A BOND RETIREMENT FUND TO THE SCHOOL DISTRICT'S
PERMANENT IMPROVEMENT FUND AND TO SEEK THE
APPROVAL OF THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS OF
CLERMONT COUNTY, OHIO FOR SUCH TRANSFER.**

WHEREAS, this board of education previously issued unlimited tax general obligation bonds in 1988 in the principal amount of \$3,020,500 (the "Bonds") for the purpose of providing building and site improvements and equipment therefor; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the amount of approximately \$408,000 remains in an account created in connection with the Bonds (the "Bond Retirement Fund"); and

WHEREAS, the Bonds have been fully paid, the related bond documents discharged and all associated accounts, with the exception of the Bond Retirement Fund have been closed; and

WHEREAS, the school district has no current debt outstanding to which funds in the Bond Retirement Fund can or should be applied.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of New Richmond Exempted Village School District, County of Clermont, Ohio:

SECTION 1. This board of education declares its intent to cause the transfer of the amount of approximately \$408,000 (plus any interest earnings thereon from the date hereof) from the Bond Retirement Fund to the school district's Permanent Improvement Fund pursuant to the statutory authority set forth in Section 5705.14(C) of the Ohio Revised Code and declares its intent to seek approval from the Court of Common Pleas of Clermont County, Ohio for such transfer.

SECTION 2. This board of education hereby authorizes the Treasurer, on behalf of the school district, to take any and all actions and to execute such affidavits, pleadings and other instruments as may be necessary in the opinion of Peck, Shaffer & Williams LLP, bond counsel, in order to effect the intent of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this board of education concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this board of education, and that all deliberations of this board of education and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
