PRESCHOOL SCREENING INFORMATION

Preschool screening is to identify **3 and 4 year old children** in the **New Richmond District**, who may be eligible to attend our program. Please bring your child and each of the following: **original** birth certificate, immunization record, social security card, and custody papers if applicable. You will also need to bring one of the following for income verification: W-2 form, payroll statement, tax returns, AFDC/food stamp case number. For address verification you will need to bring a utility bill or current driver's license. All screenings will be done at New Richmond Elementary School. Children from the NRE area will be screened Thursday, May 28, from 9:00-3:00. Monroe Elementary area screening will be Friday, May 29, from 9:00-3:00, and the Locust Corner Elementary area will be Monday, June 1, from 9:00-1:00. ***Due to limited screening time and space, please attend screening only on the day specified for the area you live in.** For more information please contact Erika Hauke at 553-3181, ext. 15206.
